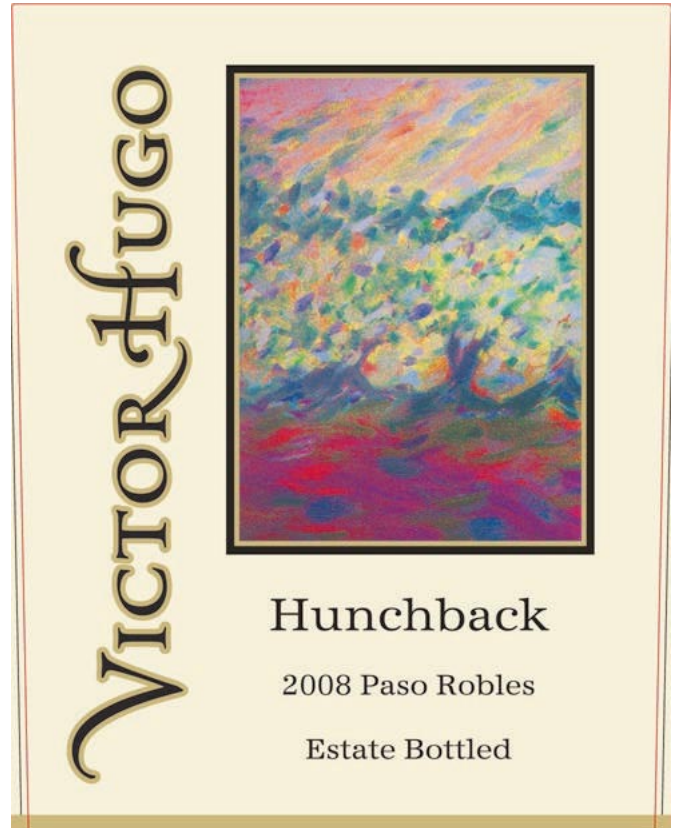
Tasting Notes

2008 Estate Hunchback

Dense, dark and delicious! Complex, inviting aromas created by multi-varietal blending. Hints of dark berries, spice and ripe plum are intertwined with subtle oak. Flavors are extended and rich with layers of pleasantly assertive tannins overlaid with hints of oak. The finish is rich and lasting which enables additional aging.

Cellaring: While enjoyable currently, this supple red blend will continue to improve with proper cellaring for another 4-7 years in the bottle with a plateau of best drinkability from 2012-2015.

Food selection: This rich, layered wine will enhance hearty beef dishes, ripe cheeses as well as pastas with rich sauces.
