2014 Quasi (Late Harvest Zinfandel)

Intense, deep aromas of black raspberry jam with notes of chocolate and toffee. Soft tannins complimented with spicy oak and a lingering rich finish.



Cellaring: While delightful now, this concentrated zinfandel port will continue to develop in the bottle with proper cellaring for another 10-15 years with a plateau of best drinkability from 2018-2028. Intense, deep aromas of black raspberry jam with notes of chocolate and toffee. Soft tannins complimented with spicy oak and a lingering rich finish.

Food selection: Think romance!! This zinfandel port enhances many desserts especially chocolate or pungent cheeses. It continues to be our favorite wine for sipping by a roaring fire.
