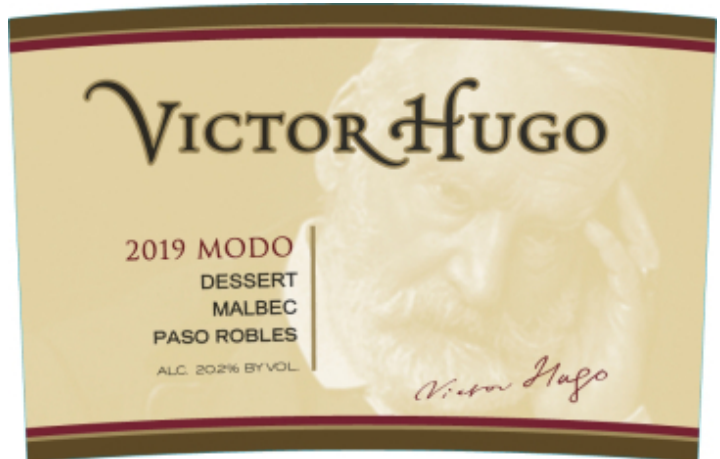

2019 Modo (Late Harvest Malbec))

Intense, deep aromas of boysenberries and baking spices with notes of chocolate. Rich, lingering tannins complimented with spicy oak and a lingering rich finish.



Cellaring: While delightful now, this concentrated Malbec port will continue to develop in the bottle with proper cellaring for another 10-15 years with a plateau of best drinkability from 2027-2037.

Food selection: Think romance!! This Malbec port enhances many desserts especially chocolate or pungent cheeses. It continues to be our favorite wine for sipping by a roaring fire.
