2020 Estate Petit Verdot

Varieties: 100% Petit Verdot



Growing conditions: Minimal winter rainfall until a wet March averted an extreme drought. No frost events but windy conditions during bloom led to a smaller fruit set. The lighter crop coupled with a long warm summer led to an outstanding earlier, small harvest with excellent quality.

Winemaking: The grapes were hand harvested, then crushed into the rotary fermentor. 24 hours later, the must was inoculated with D254 yeast then rotated hourly for 10 days prior to pressing. After completion of malo-lactic fermentation, the Petit Verdot was aged in French and Hungarian oak for 20 months prior to bottling.
